The Last Day of Lessons

The last official day for school lessons at Menai High is **Wednesday 25th September, 2019.**

ALL students will need to attend a rehearsal from **1:30pm to 2:30pm on Wednesday 26th September, 2018.**

Formal Graduation Assembly

On **Thursday 26th September, 2019**, a formal assembly will be held to farewell Year 12. This will commence at 10:30am and should finish by 12 noon. Parents are invited to this assembly. **Full school uniform (including long pants for boys and red ties for girls) is compulsory. Students who present with incorrect uniform will not participate in the graduation ceremony.**

Year 12 need to meet at the back of the hall near the basketball courts at 9:30am on that morning. **Students who wish to leave school immediately after the Graduation Ceremony must return the permission form attached to the picnic form which will be distributed Week 2, Term 3.**

Parents- please **do not** arrive at school before 10:00am. This will allow for any final organisation to be completed.

Year 12 Picnic

On **Friday 27th September, 2019** a special celebration day is being organised with a picnic at a 'mystery venue'. **The picnic day costs \$20**, which includes the bus fare, entry to venue and lunch (sausage sandwiches and soft drink). This must be **paid by 30th August, 2019.**

Students are to meet at the front of the school at 9:00am on this morning. Due to safety concerns for all involved on this day, certain conditions apply. These will be outlined on the permission note.

Students should wear appropriate mufti clothing and bring sunscreen and a hat. Water activities will be optional.

Study Vacation

Study vacation will run from the last day of school, until the first HSC exam. Students should make the most of this time, studying and preparing for their HSC.

HSC Examination

The **HSC Examinations** commence on **Thursday 17th October to Monday 11th of November, 2019.**

Students have access to their individual HSC timetable via their school's online account. This can also be viewed on the internet at www.educationstandards.nsw.edu.au (Each student must check their individual subjects for starting times).

Students are reminded to read their examination timetable carefully and arrive at least 30 minutes before the scheduled starting time. Remember that the HSC is an external examination supervised by external staff. No allowances can be made for students who arrive late or miss examinations. If travelling by public transport, check bus and/or train timetables and allow plenty of time. **The wearing of school uniform is compulsory at all HSC examinations.**

Year 12 Formal

This function will be held at **Dockside, Cockle Bay Wharf** on **Wednesday 13th November from 6:00pm-11:00pm.** There is no alcohol permitted at this function. Only current Year 12 students may attend. Students must bring their ID cards on the night. **Final payment of the \$120 must be paid by Wednesday 31st July, 2019.**

Yearbook

A committee of Year 12 students has been working very hard to produce a quality publication to celebrate the past six years of life at Menai High. We are hoping to place an order to enable students to collect copies on Clearance Day, however that is not a certainty. **Final payment of \$25.00 must be made before Wednesday 31st July, 2019.**

It will be held on **Wednesday 18th December, 2018 at 1:00pm.** This day is also the day that the ATAR results are released to all students on the UAC site. We would love everyone to come and let us know their future plans, whether it be a gap year, university, TAFE or work.


